Curriculum (stamped by the issuing university)
Subject descriptions (stamped by the issuing university)
Receipt for the study application fee

All documents must be official, original, issued by the competent authorities and legalised through diplomatic channels (by the Spanish consulate in the foreign country and then by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation in Madrid), except documents issued in European Union countries, which need not be legalised, or countries that have signed the Hague Convention of 5 October 1961, in which case they require the corresponding apostille (abbreviated legalisation) from the competent authorities in that country. Documents issued in countries that have signed the Andrés Bello Convention, which was adopted in 1970 and amended in November 1990, can be legalised through diplomatic channels, which eliminates the need for legalisation by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation in Madrid. All of the documents must have been translated into Catalan or Spanish by a sworn translator.

Once the photocopies have been stamped and legalised by the diplomatic or consular body of the applicant's country in Spain, the original documents are no longer necessary.
